ETHICS GUIDELINES FOR TOWN ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Members of advisory boards and commissions shall not discuss, advocate, or vote on any matter in which they have a conflict of interest or an interest which reasonably might appear to be in conflict with the concept of fairness in dealing with public business. A conflict of interest or a potential conflict occurs if a member has a separate, private, or monetary interest, either direct or indirect, in any issue or transaction under consideration. In addition, members of the Historic District Commission and Board of Adjustment, when these boards are hearing cases, serve as quasi-judicial bodies. Pursuant to State Statute 106A-388(e)(2), members of these boards “shall not participate in or vote on any quasi-judicial matter in a manner that would violate affected persons’ constitutional rights to an impartial decision maker. Impermissible violations of due process include, but are not limited to, a member having a fixed opinion prior to hearing the matter that is not susceptible to change, undisclosed ex parte communications, a close familial, business, or other associational relationship with an affected person, or a financial interest in the outcome of the matter.” Any member who violates these Ethics Guidelines may be subject to removal from the board or commission. If the advisory board or commission member believes he/she has a conflict of interest then that member should ask the advisory board or commission to be recused from voting. The advisory board or commission should then vote on the question on whether or not to excuse the member making the request. In cases where the individual member or the advisory board or commission establishes a conflict of interest, then the advisory board or commission member shall remove themselves from the voting area. Any advisory board or commission member may seek the counsel of the Town Attorney on questions regarding the interpretation of these ethics guidelines or other conflict of interest matters. The interpretation may include a recommendation on whether or not the advisory board or commission member should excuse himself/herself from voting. The advisory board or commission member may request the Town Attorney respond in writing.

There is a great deal of racial and social inequality in this country that is perpetuated by structural forces including but not limited to housing access, employment access/supports, mental health access/costs, police policies and enforcement, and addiction interventions. The lack of availability of the positive forms of these resources, coupled with the presence of harmful (punitive) forms of the resources, fosters inequality and public health and safety concerns. I believe that my experience (outlined below) and, likely more importantly, the experience of community members with whom I am partnered, will allow me to contribute valuable perspective and practical implementable solutions. I have a Bachelor's in Psychology and Criminology, and I am getting my Master's degree in Social Work at UNC. I have had the opportunity to work with a great number of diverse populations as well. I have experience working with people experiencing addiction, criminal justice involvement, homelessness, trauma, racism, cognitive/intellectual/physical disability, and more recently young adults aging out of foster care. I have also been involved with the Behavioral Health Task Force, the Familiar Faces Task Force, the HOME Committee, the Criminal Justice and Health Working Group, the Criminal Justice Awareness and Action organization, and others to varying degrees. This is not to say I am an expert, nor would I ever claim to be one, but I do know how to listen and engage stakeholders in the conversation while still being solution oriented and practical. My goal is to add my experience and the communities perspective by engaging stakeholders and community members both in the organizations I just listed and throughout the area. I hope my application will come second to those less heard voices and that if I am offered a seat, it will be to ensure the decisions/conclusions made by the RCSTF reflect the views, values, and resources of Chapel Hill.

I am a life long North Carolinian and a more recent Chapel Hill resident—there are few things that matter more to me than making our state and community a wonderful, safe place for all. ETHICS GUIDELINES FOR TOWN ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

Members of advisory boards and commissions shall not discuss, advocate, or vote on any matter in which they have a conflict of interest or an interest which reasonably might appear to be in conflict with the concept of fairness in dealing with public business. A conflict of interest or a potential conflict occurs if a member has a separate, private, or monetary interest, either direct or indirect, in any issue or transaction under consideration. In addition, members of the Historic District Commission and Board of Adjustment, when these boards are hearing cases, serve as quasi-judicial bodies. Pursuant to State Statute 106A-388(e)(2), members of these boards “shall not participate in or vote on any quasi-judicial matter in a manner that would violate affected persons’ constitutional rights to an impartial decision maker. Impermissible violations of due process include, but are not limited to, a member having a fixed opinion prior to hearing the matter that is not susceptible to change, undisclosed ex parte communications, a close familial, business, or other associational relationship with an affected person, or a financial interest in the outcome of the matter.” Any member who violates these Ethics Guidelines may be subject to removal from the board or commission. If the advisory board or commission member believes he/she has a conflict of interest then that member should ask the advisory board or commission to be recused from voting. The advisory board or commission should then vote on the question on whether or not to excuse the member making the request. In cases where the individual member or the advisory board or commission establishes a conflict of interest, then the advisory board or commission member shall remove themselves from the voting area. Any advisory board or commission member may seek the counsel of the Town Attorney on questions regarding the interpretation of these ethics guidelines or other conflict of interest matters. The interpretation may include a recommendation on whether or not the advisory board or commission member should excuse himself/herself from voting. The advisory board or commission member may request the Town Attorney respond in writing.

Growing up in Chapel Hill as a refugee is hard. I watch my parents struggle to find resources so that life won't be so difficult in Chapel Hill. It is not easy for them to find these resources. For example, there is no interpreter when they have to go to a housing meeting or need to fill out a government document. Language is a barrier for them, and I feel that there is a need for the town to provide interpreters, as well as other resources, for the members of our community who struggle to get the help they need. After watching my parents struggle, I began to work with a nonprofit organization called Refugee Community Partnership (RCP). I began working with them as part of the Carrboro High School branch, and I have continued to work with them as a UNC student. RCP's main goal is to reach out to refugee families from many backgrounds (Burmese, Karen, Syrian and Congolese) and provide support and resources. Working directly with these families has helped me see that many people share my parents' experience at town, county, and school offices. In addition, members of the Historic District Commission and Board of Adjustment, when these boards are hearing cases, serve as quasi-judicial bodies. Pursuant to State Statute 106A-388(e)(2), members of these boards “shall not participate in or vote on any quasi-judicial matter in a manner that would violate affected persons’ constitutional rights to an impartial decision maker. Impermissible violations of due process include, but are not limited to, a member having a fixed opinion prior to hearing the matter that is not susceptible to change, undisclosed ex parte communications, a close familial, business, or other associational relationship with an affected person, or a financial interest in the outcome of the matter.” Any member who violates these Ethics Guidelines may be subject to removal from the board or commission. If the advisory board or commission member believes he/she has a conflict of interest then that member should ask the advisory board or commission to be recused from voting. The advisory board or commission should then vote on the question on whether or not to excuse the member making the request. In cases where the individual member or the advisory board or commission establishes a conflict of interest, then the advisory board or commission member shall remove themselves from the voting area. Any advisory board or commission member may seek the counsel of the Town Attorney on questions regarding the interpretation of these ethics guidelines or other conflict of interest matters.
