TESTING & RESULTS

Nasal Swab (PCR) Testing is 100% free.

Nasal Swab Test:

- Results will be available on average in 3 days
- Providers will contact patients via text message with positive or negative results

*The PCR test is covered by insurance or submitted for reimbursement through the CARES Act
