WHEREAS, in 2010, under the direction of Town Manager Roger Stancil, a committee was formed to investigate a way to reduce healthcare claims and enhance employee wellness and safety programs, and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Town of Chapel Hill collaborated with UNC Family Medicine to open an Employee Health Clinic, staffed by a nurse practitioner, nutritionist, tobacco cessation specialist, and additional staff, and

WHEREAS, since 2011, the Clinic Staff has provided program and support service to help Town employees achieve their wellness goals, and

WHEREAS, the Clinic staff has partnered with the Town Employee Wellness Committee to promote healthy lifestyles and integrate wellness into our organizational culture, and

WHEREAS, the Town conveys the deep appreciation of the Employee Health Clinic Providers and Staff for service and commitment to the wellbeing for all Town employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill recognizes and honors the significant contributions of UNC Family Medicine and Liska Lackley to the Employee Health Clinic and the health and wellness of the Town's employees.
