

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MAYOR PRO TEM CAMILLE BERRY AS THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL'S VOTING DELEGATE TO THE NORTH CAROLINA LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES (NCLM) (2026-03-25/R-4)

WHEREAS, the North Carolina League of Municipalities (NCLM) conducts its annual Board of Directors election through an electronic voting process, and each member municipality is authorized to designate one voting delegate to cast votes on behalf of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the NCLM requires that voting delegates be designated on or before April 13, 2026, after which delegates will receive credentials and instructions for the voting period scheduled from April 13–21, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Pro Tem Camille Berry has expressed interest in serving in this role and has been identified by the Mayor as the preferred representative for the Town for the 2026 voting process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that Mayor Pro Tem Camille Berry is hereby appointed to serve as the Town of Chapel Hill's designated voting delegate to the North Carolina League of Municipalities for purposes of the 2026 Board of Directors election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk is authorized and directed to submit the required Voting Delegate Form to the NCLM by the established deadline.
