

RESOLUTION A

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PRINCIPLES OF PROTECTION FOR ENTRANCEWAYS (2023-04-19/R-8)

WHEREAS, Chapel Hill and Carrboro have mutually entered into an agreement on establishing WHEKEAS, Chapter his and Carrourd have thousany entered an annexation boundary line between the two Towns; and


