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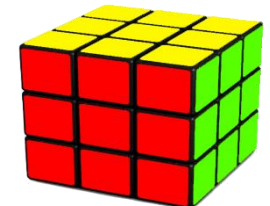


Background

- Ongoing interest from the Town Council to refine and further streamline the HS process and for programs funded to be more results oriented.
- Recent process improvements:
 - Revised application
 - Scoring sheet for application evaluation

Challenges with Current HS Process

- Town currently funds dozens of agencies at varied amounts who work on a board range of issues
- Lack of holistic focus on results or evaluation of overall impact
- Our priority areas are broad – safety net services, education, and health
- Significant time commitment required for staff, HSAB members, and agencies
- Opportunities to deepen impact by focusing on specific outcomes and results



Proposed Evaluation Process

- Staff has designed a process to evaluate the HS Program, using a design thinking approach. The intended outcome:
 - ✓ Result driven funding process that achieves the goals of the Town and is responsive to the community's greatest needs
 - ✓ Clearly defined funding priority areas, goals and outcome measures that are shared regularly with the Council and Community
 - ✓ A streamline funding process that does not unduly burden nonprofit agencies, HSAB or staff and maintains a collaborative, cross-jurisdictional spirit



Proposed Methodology

- Review of 2020 Plan and Council Goals
- Research national best practices
- Review of Census and other data sources
- HSAB vet priority areas and create goals and outcomes
- Focus groups with Human Agencies partners

Proposed Timeline

- Data Collection (January – March)
 - Staff – priority areas, research of models, review of Census data
 - HSAB – goals statements and outcomes measures
 - Agencies – review of goal statements and outcomes measures
- Council approval of priority areas, goals and outcome measures (April)
- Amend application and process components (May-June)
- Implement new program model for FY19-20 funding cycle (fall 2018)
