The Transportation and Connectivity Advisory Board is strongly opposed to the plan proposed in Map 4A of the I-40 widening project.

We recommend that Council only approve a plan for widening I-40 if it minimizes impacts to the surrounding neighborhoods, includes meaningful accommodations for bicyclists and pedestrians, harmonizes with the imminent BRT project, and creates a gateway to Chapel Hill that is welcoming to all visitors and residents.
