1. Addressing a national crisis on a local level.

The shortage of affordable housing is a nation-wide crisis that local municipalities are striving to solve. The P.E.A.C.H. Apartments are a solution to this crisis providing 10 affordable units distinctly for families earning 30% Area Median Income (AMI).



2. Supporting cross-sector collaboration



Building P.E.A.C.H. is a team effort involving multiple sectors and partners. That's why the Town of Chapel Hill donated part of the land used to build P.E.A.C.H. and support affordable housing. P.E.A.C.H. is a zero-debt financed project, which is why collaboration is crucial for the project's success.

3. Uplifting an integral population of our community

Chapel Hill is not only a university town but also a pre-existing community. Many of these community members are service workers and university employees whose pay does not match the dignity of their work. P.E.A.C.H. can provide a quality affordable housing option to those who work make our community better.



4. Serving All Diverse Populations



The P.E.A.C.H. Apartments will supply vulnerable populations with a variety of floor plans including ADA-accessible units. These include two studio, four one-bedroom, three two-bedroom, and one three-bedroom apartments. This allows for a diverse selection of families and individuals to be served.

5. The community believes in P.E.A.C.H.

Many organizations and donors have shown support and belief in the impact of the \$3.5M P.E.A.C.H. project. Through multiple funding cycles, the P.E.A.C.H. project has committed funding of about \$1.3 million from benefactors. However, more is needed to have the desired impact on the community.
