Subject: Council Questions: Item 4: HOME Plan

<u>Council Question</u>: Could you provide details on the acquisition by EmPOWERment - Is \$145,000 the full amount of the property? Knowing that we generally strive to leverage other funding sources so that we are not funding the full cost of acquiring a property, I am wondering if there is more information as to why we seem to be funding the full amount in this case?

Staff Response: The total project cost is \$170,000, with \$25,000 in private funds being leveraged for this acquisition. Affordable Rental Housing has been identified as an Orange County priority in Orange County 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan. The Orange County Affordable Housing Collaborative is working on creating scoring criteria for future funding cycles, to include the amount of leveraged funding.

<u>Council Question</u>: In Chapel Hill, what are the community housing development organizations (CHDOs) aside from CASA and Community Home Trust?

<u>Staff Response</u>: Our understanding from Orange County staff is that CASA and the Community Home Trust are the only certified CHDO's operating in Orange County.
