AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CAPITAL PROJECTS ORDINANCE FOR PUBLIC BUILDINGS (2018-05-02/0-3)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, that the capital projects ordinance for public buildings is hereby amended as follows:

"SECTION I

The capital projects as authorized by the Town Council include building improvements funded from bonds for energy efficiency building improvements.

SECTION II

The Manager of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with implementation of these projects within terms of funds appropriated here.
