- Say more about regional partners

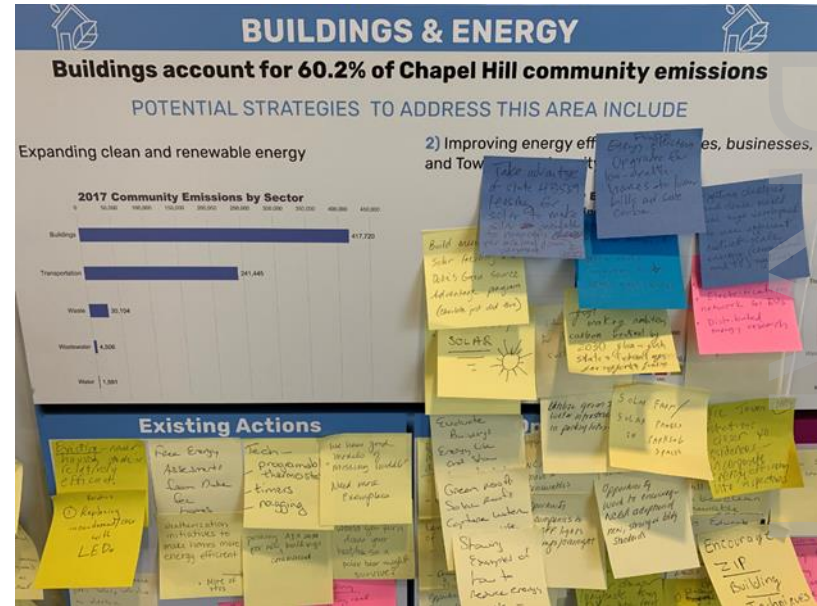
