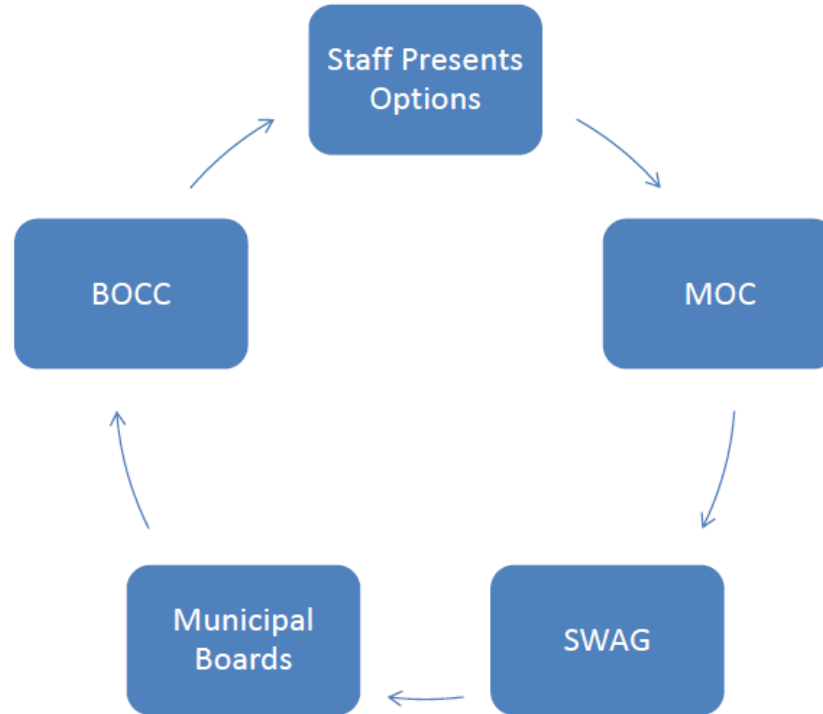

Key Issues

- Funding
 - Solid Waste Programs Fee
- Debt
- Termination



Key Issues

- Termination
 - Notice: 12 months
 - Termination Fee: Equals Solid Waste Programs Fee times the number of billed units in the withdrawing jurisdiction
 - Due: Upon the effective date of termination
 - Solid Waste Programs Fee: Continues to be billed for the withdrawing jurisdiction during the year of withdrawal
