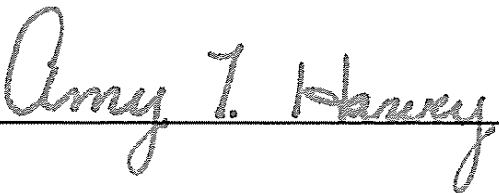

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CAROLINA SUNROCK LLC IN AN AMOUNT OF \$689,538.10 FOR STREET RESURFACING (2018-06-27/R-4)

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill solicited formal bids for street resurfacing on the Town website on May 2, 2018 in accordance with G.S. 143-129; and

WHEREAS, three responsive bids were received and opened on May 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the responsive bids were evaluated and Carolina Sunrock LLC was determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the bid permits an increase or decrease of up to 25% in the scope of work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council authorizes the Town Manager to execute a contract with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Carolina Sunrock LLC, in an amount of \$689,538.10 including the base bid of \$674,043.00 and Alternate II for \$15,495.10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager is authorized to approve change orders up to a 5% contingency, which is a total amount of \$724,015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager is authorized to extend the base bid contract twice at the same base unit price by a one-year contract addendum if mutually agreeable to the Town and Carolina Sunrock LLC.
