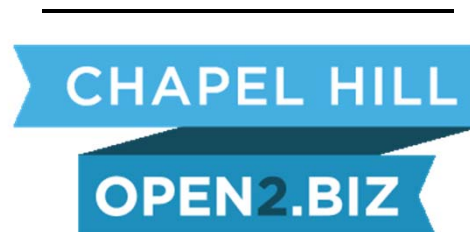

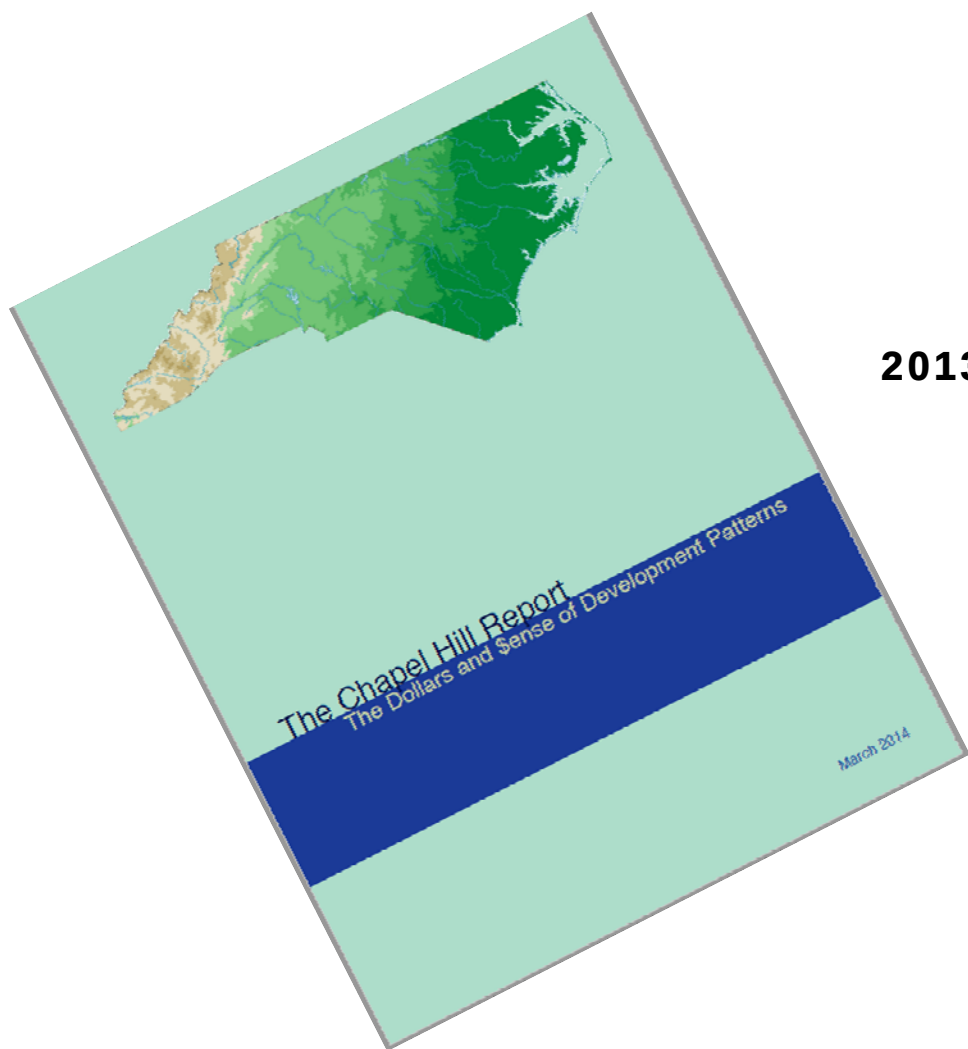

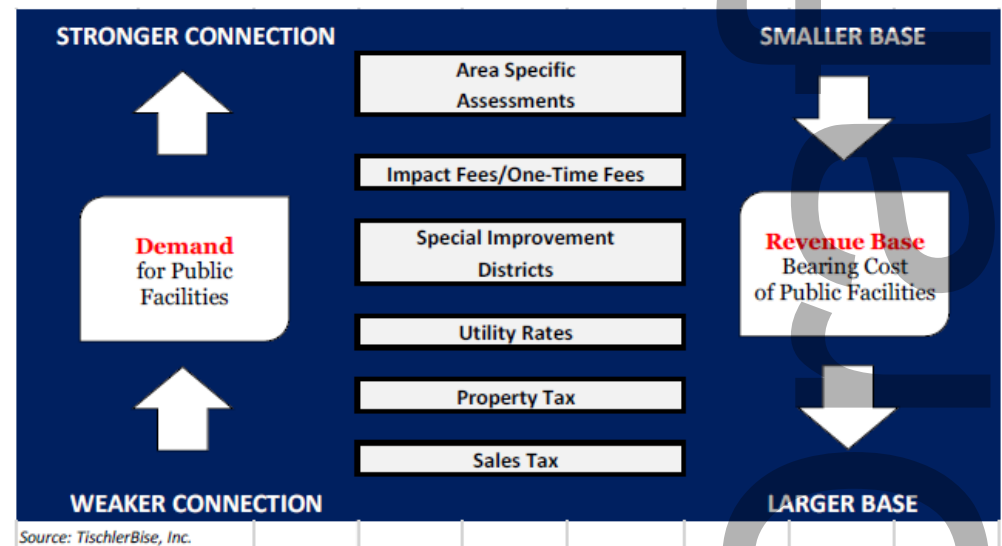

These items may include:

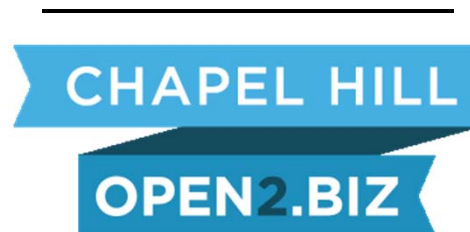
