

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH TURNER ASPHALT GC, LLC IN AN AMOUNT OF \$792,047.50 FOR THE HILLSBOROUGH STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (2018-10-17/R-2)

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill solicited formal bids for Hillsborough Street reconstruction on the Town website on August 23, 2018 in accordance with G.S. 143-129; and

WHEREAS, two responsive bids were received and opened on October 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, staff evaluated the responsive bids and determined Turner Asphalt GC, LLC to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council authorizes the Town Manager to execute a contract with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Turner Asphalt GC, LLC, in the amount of \$792,047.50, including the base bid of \$745,757.50, and Alternate II for \$31,090 and Alternate III for \$15,200.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager is authorized to approve change orders as necessary provided that the contract cost remains within the amount budgeted of \$850,000.
