WHEREAS, farmers' markets provide a vehicle to educate the community on the nutritional, environmental, and economic value of buying local, sustainably-produced farm products; and

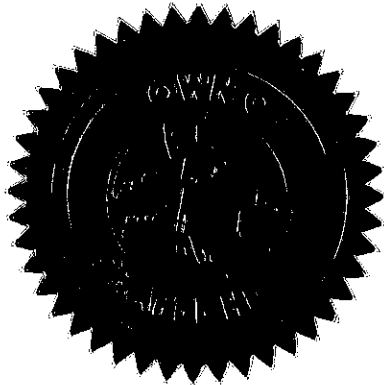
WHEREAS, Farmers of Orange and The Chapel Hill Farmers' Market is celebrating 10 years of service to Chapel Hill and surrounding communities; and
