

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ENGAGE WITH THE COMMUNITY ON ALL FUTURE LAND USE MAP ELEMENTS DURING SUMMER AND FALL OF 2019 (2019-06-26/R-9)

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2017, the Council for the Town of Chapel Hill initiated a project to Rewrite the Town's Land Use Management Ordinance (LUMO) and requested that the ordinance rewrite process begin with an effort to refine the Town's Future Land Use Map (FLUM); and

WHEREAS, since the Council for the Town of Chapel Hill has, for the past year and half, worked to produce a draft Future Land Use Map in order to communicate a vision for Chapel Hill in 2049; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Chapel Hill actively seeks community engagement to ensure full community participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council authorize the Town Manager to engage with the community on all FLUM elements during the summer and early fall of 2019 after the Blueprint has been revised into a Draft FLUM.
