

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FY23-24 CHAPEL HILL TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT APPLICATION TO THE TRIANGLE J COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (2022-12-07/R-4)

WHEREAS, the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization has provided funding to the Triangle J Council of Governments to support Transportation Demand Management activities in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill has received Transportation Demand Management funding in FY22-23 and coordinates with the University of North Carolina and the Town of Carrboro in Transportation Demand Management program promotions; and

WHEREAS, the Town has developed a program of Transportation Demand Management activities as part of the FY23-24 Transportation Demand Management grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro will be a sub-recipient of the FY23-24 Transportation Demand Management grant; and

WHEREAS, Town staff will support and administer GoChapelHill!, the Town's Transportation Demand Management program, which requires a 50 percent match of the total program budget; and

WHEREAS, a resolution is required from the Town of Chapel Hill supporting the TDM grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Town Council supports the FY23-24 Chapel Hill Transportation Demand Management grant application to the Triangle J Council of Governments.
