**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2026-27 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (2026-04-29/R-1)**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill used multiple methods to receive public input on use of 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the Town of the 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant allocation of \$432,113; and

WHEREAS, the Town identified \$173,482 in prior years' CDBG Grant funds to be reallocated this program year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that based on the Town's available funding of \$605,595 of 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant funds, the Council approves the following 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant Program Funding Plan:
