We need to find a new space to meet operational, training, and service goals.


Coal Ash

We recommend leasing space at 7300 Millhouse Road to house the Police Department.


We expect to receive the Brownfields Agreement shortly.






























Why lease?

- It's an expensive time to build
- Least impact on debt capacity/fund
- Fastest way to address CHPD's needs

Lease terms

- 60,000 square feet
- \$1.3 million base rent/year one
- Fifteen-year lease

Next Steps for Council

June 12, 2024

Open the public hearing, receive comment, close the hearing

June 17, 2024

- Make findings of fact in support of the application to the Local Government Commission (LGC) for approval of the lease
- Authorize the Town Manager to take the steps necessary to execute the lease.

Next Steps for Staff

- Submit lease to the LGC for approval
- Sign lease after LGC approval
- Work on upfit design and schedule with landlord
- Move staff and operations
- Ribbon Cutting for new Police Department approx. 8 months after lease is signed.
