Subject: Council Questions: Item 11: Text Amendment: U1 Zoning District

<u>Council Question:</u> Are the text amendment changes mandated by state law, so that even if we didn't change our ordinance, state law would prevail?

<u>Staff Response:</u> The LUMO text amendments are not mandated by state law, but are necessary before this proposed agreement could be approved.

<u>Council Question:</u> Why is there no specific definition of "long range" in Section 2 of 3.5.5, subsection D? Seems like that could open us to some problems down the line.

<u>Staff Response:</u> "Long range" would be something that the Council could determine on a case by case basis. In some cases, long range could be decades and in other cases a much shorter time period, depending on the size of the particular site and proposed development.
