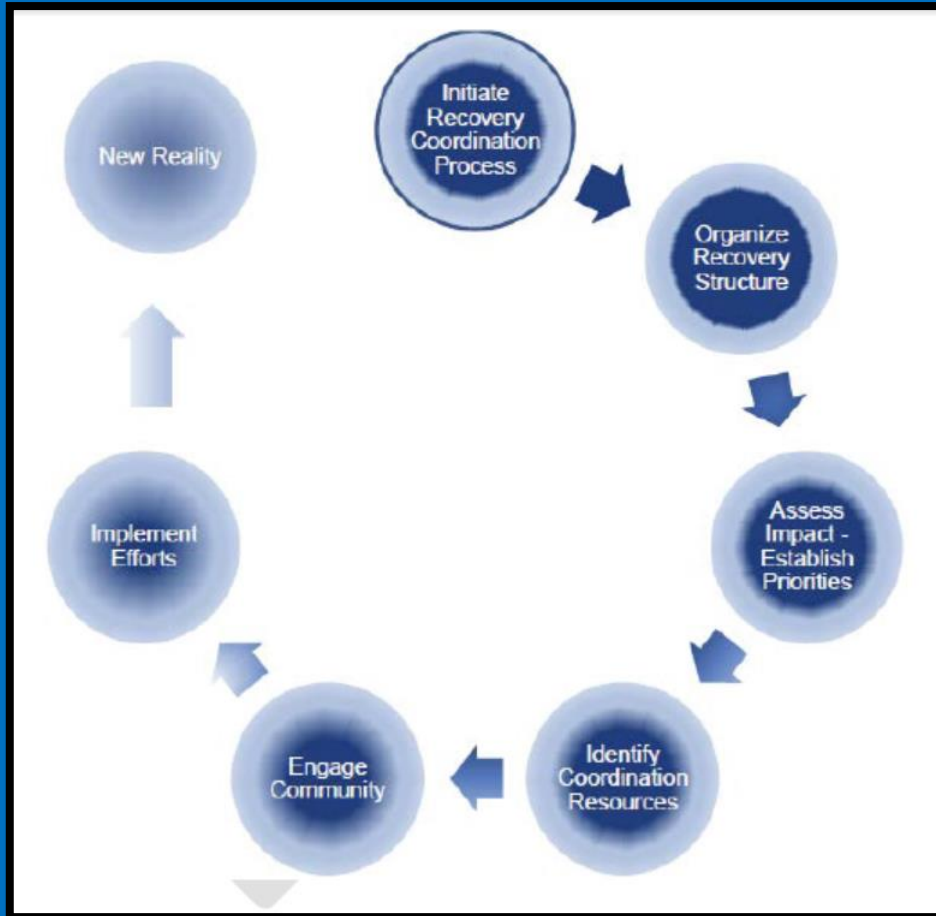

<b>Barbers/Salons/Massage</b>	<b>Closed</b>	<b>No change</b>
<b>Theaters, Music Venues, Bowling Alleys</b>	<b>Closed</b>	<b>No change</b>
<b>Gyms &amp; Playgrounds</b>	<b>Closed</b>	<b>No change</b>
<b>Longterm Care Centers Visitors</b>	<b>Not allowed</b>	<b>No change</b>
<b>Worship Services</b>	<b>Outdoor services allowed</b>	<b>No change</b>
<b>Face Coverings</b>	<b>Encouraged</b>	<b>No change</b>

# PHASE 1 – WHAT IS DIFFERENT

	<b>Through 5 p.m. May 8</b>	<b>Phase 1</b>
<b>Commercial activity</b>	Only leave home for essential purposes	Can leave home for commercial activity
<b>Retail</b>	20% capacity allowed	50% capacity allowed with cleaning/social distancing
<b>Gatherings</b>	10-person limit (generally discouraged)	10-person limit (allowed outdoors with friends)
<b>Childcare</b>	Open for essential workers	Open for working parents or those looking for work
<b>State Parks and Trails*</b>	Location discretion	Opening encouraged (*no playgrounds)
