





# Fifth & Detroit Reconstruction & Streetscape

Drivers stopping for pedestrians increased from **48%** to **97%** after the project construction.

**15%** visitor increase after construction compared to **0%** increase for Kerrytown as a whole.

**43%** reduction in speeding drivers on First Street






### **State Street Streetscape & Reconstruction**

**3** blocks of curbless street in the heart of State Street to provide great accessibility and flexibility for special events & outdoor dining


