- Involved in social justice issues in the local community
 - Supported three refugee families
 - Run an Open Food Pantry on 15/501
 - Have a Giving Garden where thousands of pounds of fresh food are grown for those experiencing food scarcity
 - Awarded NC Civil Rights Trail Marker to honor 1964 sit-ins at the Watts Grill.
 - Committed to equity, affordable housing






Holy Trinity Seeks Permanent Home

- Partnership between HT and a local developer to buy land
- 50 acres with two creeks:
- +/-12 acres for the church
- Land for creek protection
- +/-35 acres to be developed into approx. 150 townhomes as a "missing middle" community

Developed in two phases:

Phase 1: Build the church – not in OWASA service area


Phase 2: Build the community with water and sewer lines – expect to submit concept plan in January
