Recommended Action

Council adopt R-#, to grant the Town Manager the authority to establish and administer a unified local affordable housing funding program

Legislative Context

- Prior Council action established eligible uses for 3 separate affordable housing funding sources
- In 2023, Council approved the Affordable Housing Plan and Investment Strategy which recommends realigning funding procedures to increase efficiency, transparency, and equity



Background & Context

- Town has 3 separate affordable housing funding sources with similar eligible uses
- Housing partners and funding applicants have expressed confusion about differences between different sources
- Administrative burden is higher for partners and staff



Tradeoffs & Impacts

- Changes would simplify and clarify funding allocation process
- Changes would reduce administrative burden on partners and Town staff

Financial Impact

- No funding requests or decisions required
- Staff will initiate next funding round in February 2025



Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

- Proposal aligns with Affordable Housing Plan recommendations, which centers racial equity throughout its recommendations
- Town staff will continue to consider social and racial equity in its evaluation of funding applications



Community Engagement

- Affordable Housing Plan included robust engagement of key stakeholders
- Staff recently distributed online survey gathering feedback from past applicants on Town funding process
