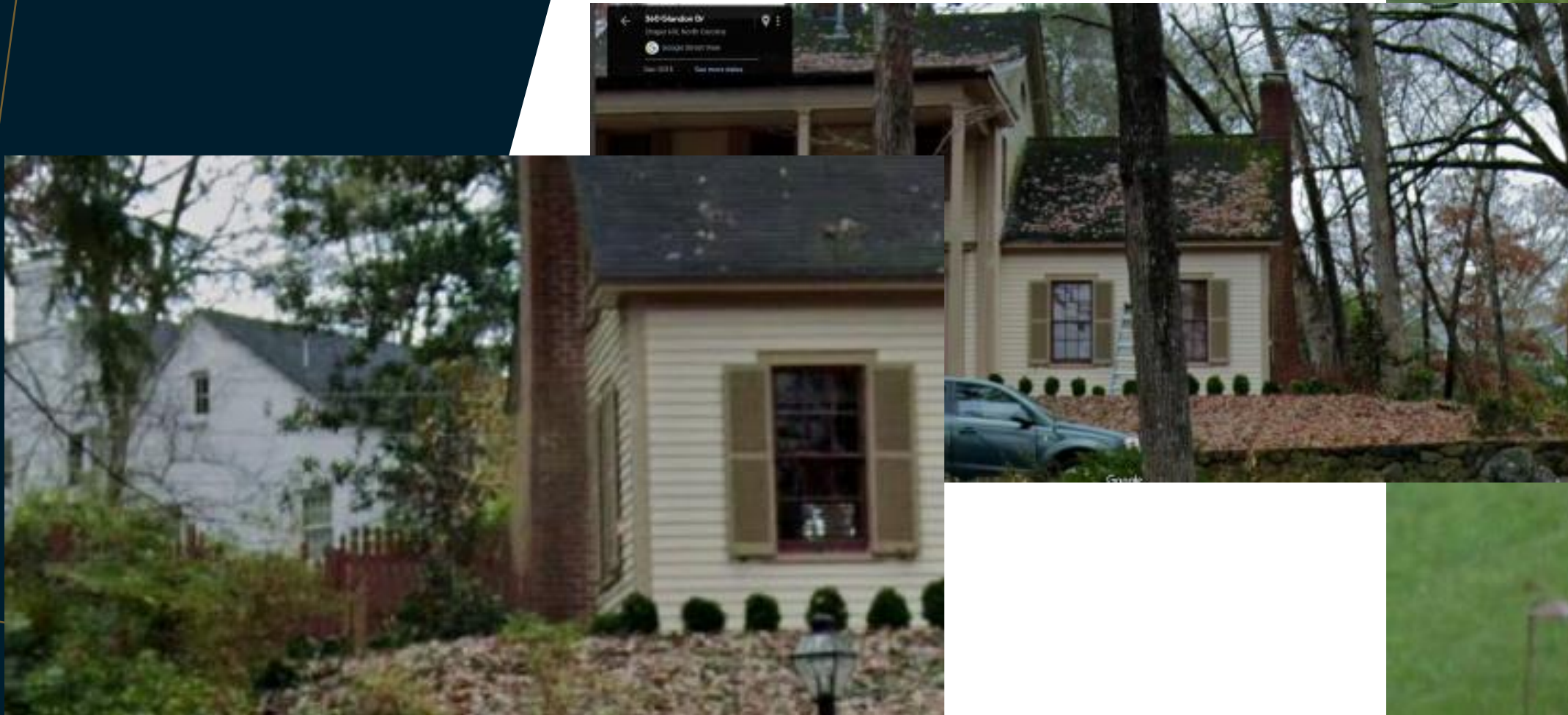

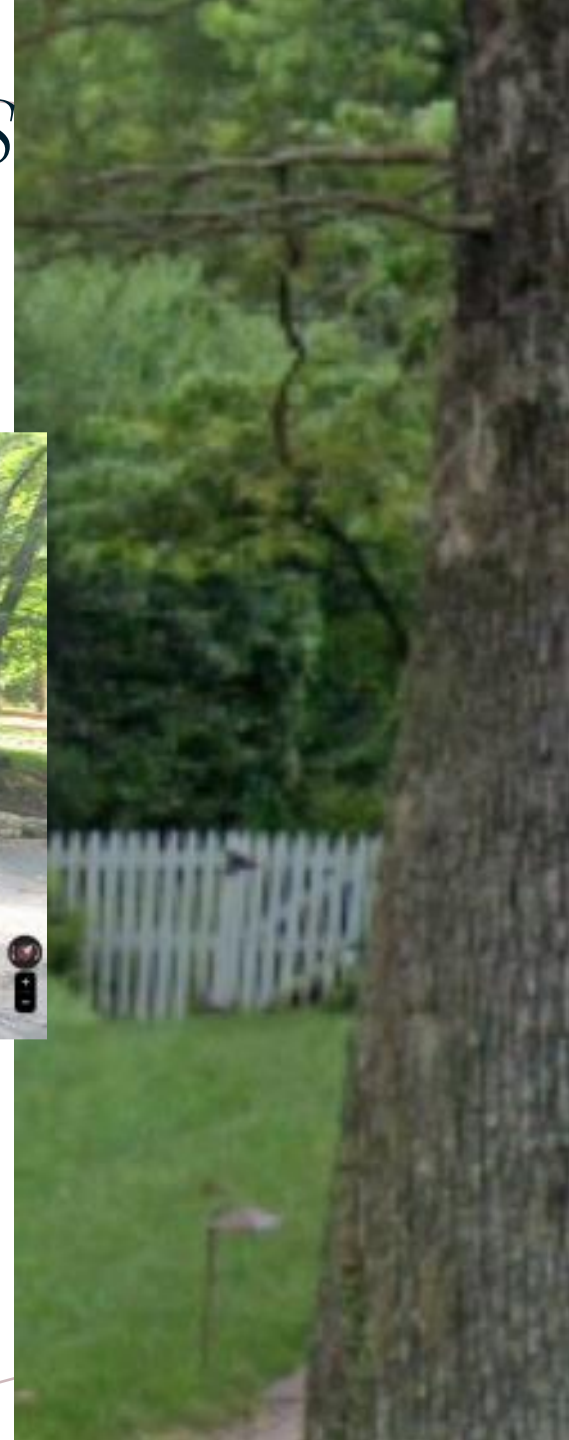

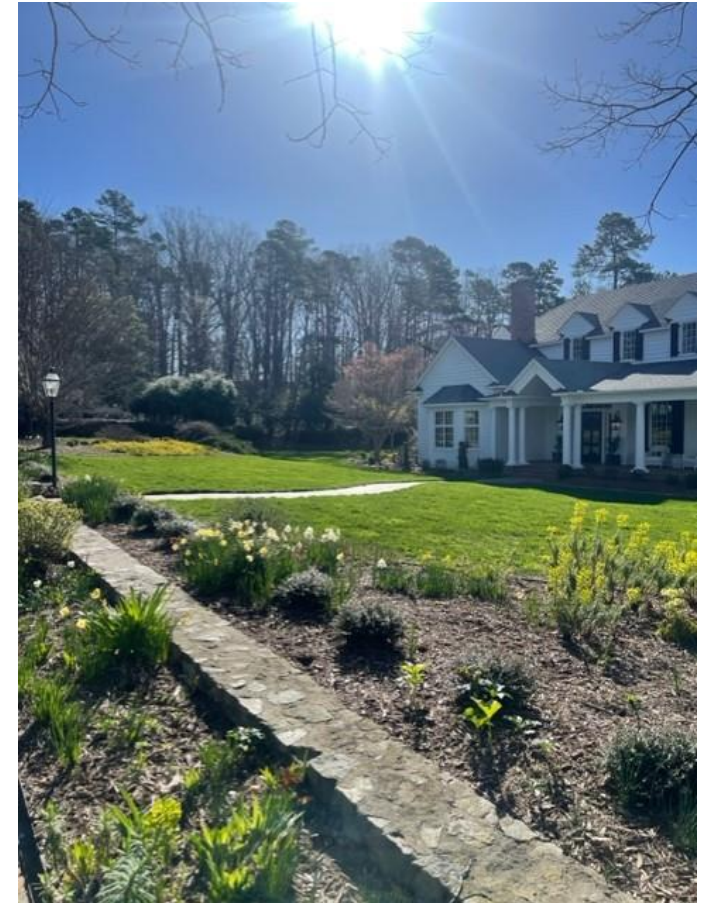

# *PROPOSAL:*

The Gimghoul District is primarily fenced with wooden fences. There are many more that are not shown here.

Many Wooden Fences are in the front areas of the yard and many run along the sides of the yard to the sidewalk.

We have determined that the most appropriate fence that would be in alignment with the neighborhood, match the specific architecture/colors/style of the existing home, show historical accuracy and honor Gimghoul and the greater Chapel Hill Historic district would be a white picket fence.

## **HISTORICAL ACCURACY TO COLONIAL REVIVAL:**

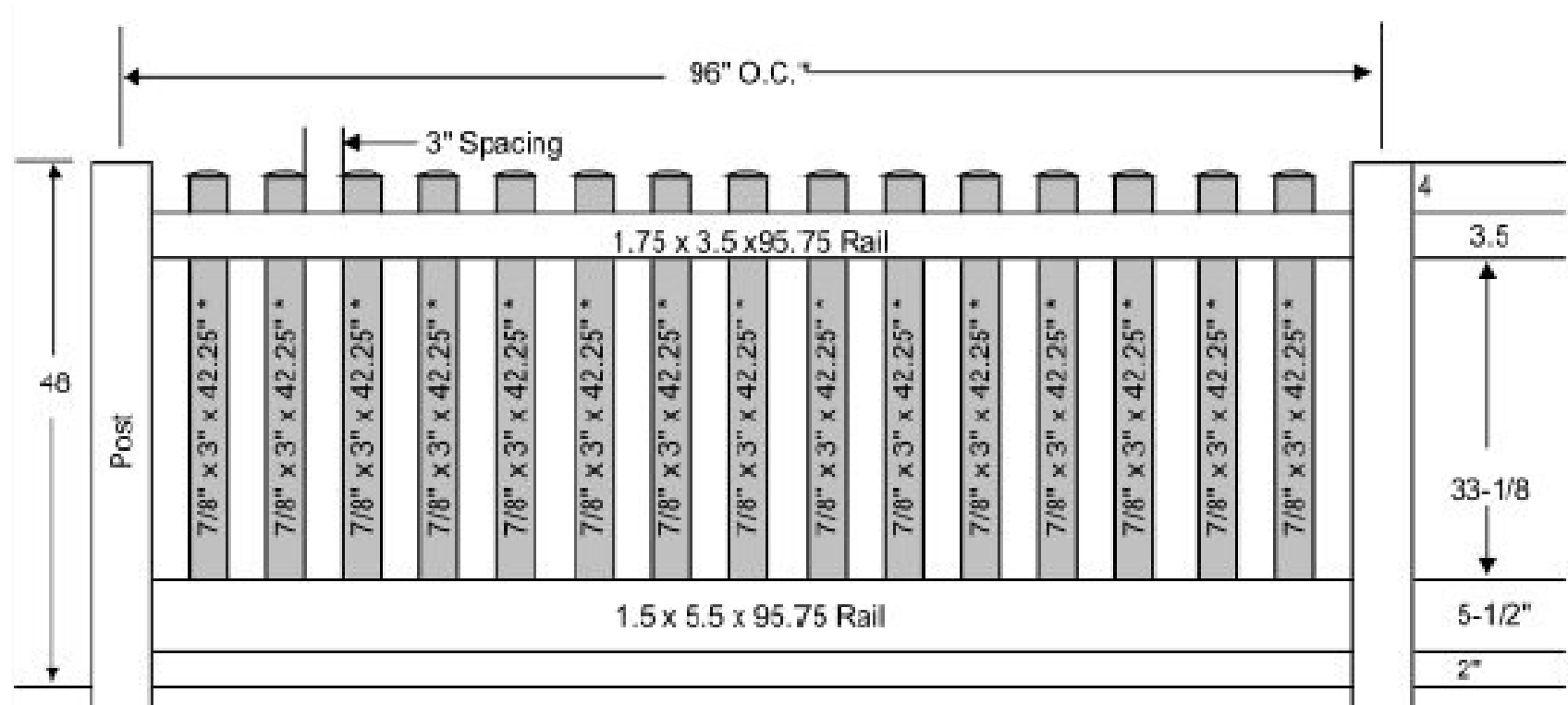
