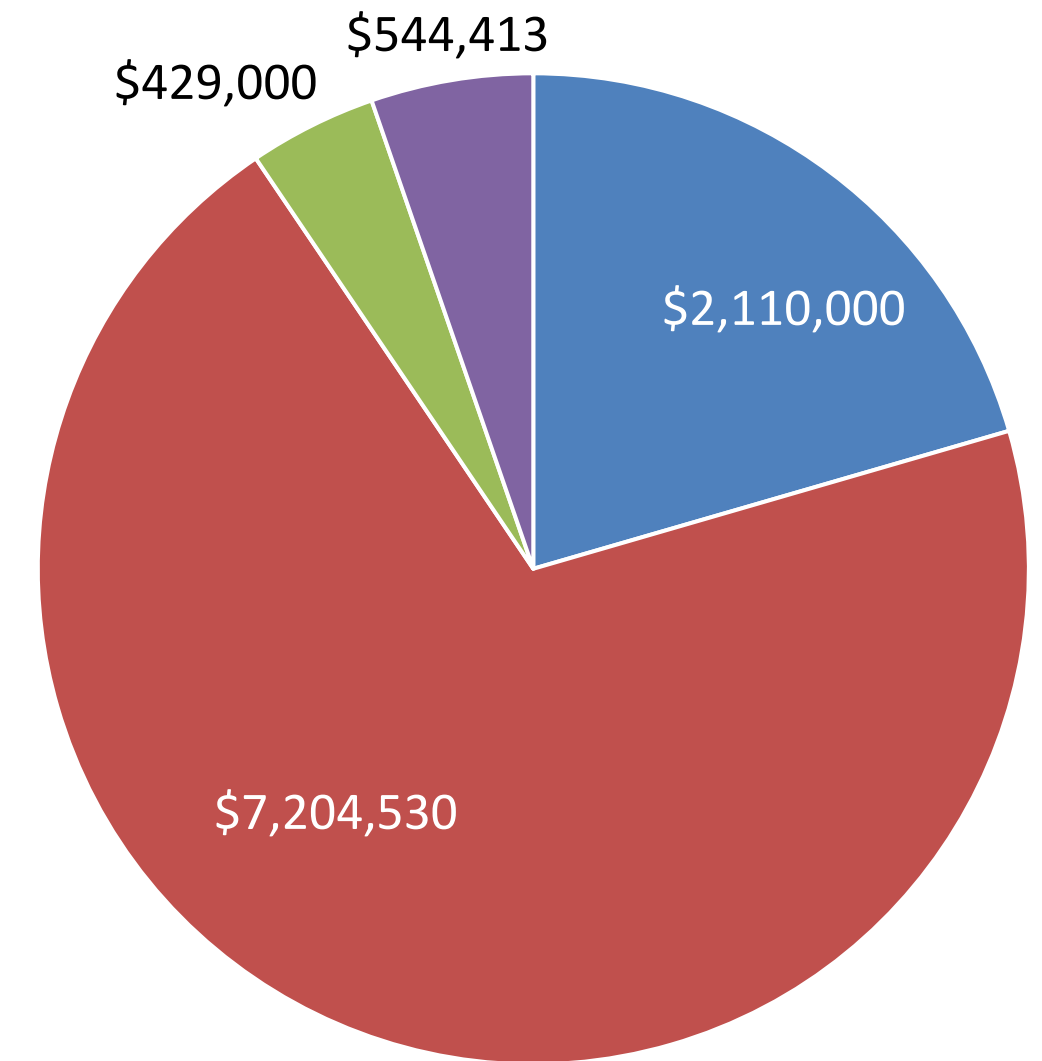
Orange County Partnership to End Homelessness

- Established in 2008 to support 10-Year Plan to End Chronic Homelessness
- 2022 Updated the Memorandum of Understanding
 - Council and staff representation in the Partnership
 - Outlines Towns and County funding for 3 positions
- Mayors, Managers and Chairs Human Services and Housing Committee discussing roles and allocation of resources

Town Efforts to Combat Homelessness

- Creating and preserving affordable housing
- Financial support for homelessness gaps
- Chapel Hill Crisis Unit

Challenges to be Addressed

- Identifying funding for development of units that serve people transitioning out of homelessness
- More fully meeting the need for emergency shelter and aligning existing models with best practices
- Clarifying and aligning funding commitments with municipal roles and responsibilities
