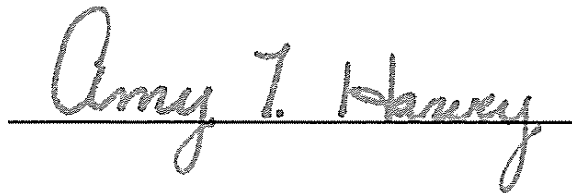

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CAROLINA SUNROCK, LLC IN AN AMOUNT OF \$4,809,529.95 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE ESTES DRIVE BICYCLE-PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS AND APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS WITHIN THE BUDGETED AMOUNT (2021-05-26/R-2)

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill solicited formal bids for Estes Drive Bicycle-Pedestrian Improvements on the Town website on April 13, 2021 in accordance with N.C. General Statute Sec. 143-129; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill held a pre-bid conference on April 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, three responsive bids were received and opened on May 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the responsive bids were evaluated and Carolina Sunrock, LLC was determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council authorizes the Town Manager to execute a contract with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Carolina Sunrock, LLC, in an amount of \$4,809,529.95.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager is authorized to approve change orders as necessary provided that the contract cost remains within the budgeted amount.
