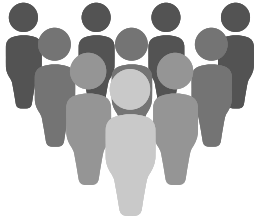

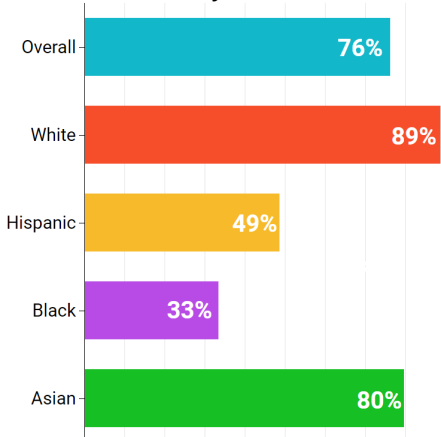

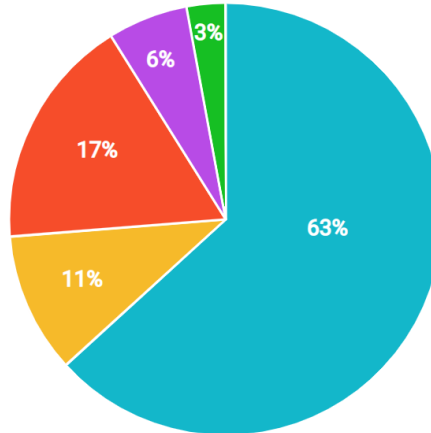
COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS ³

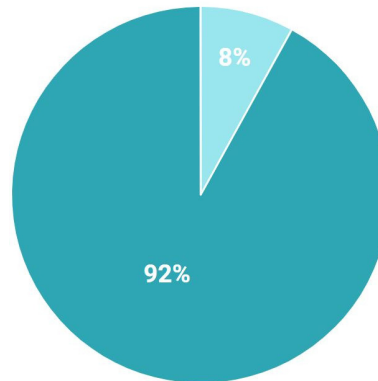

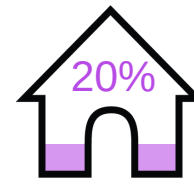

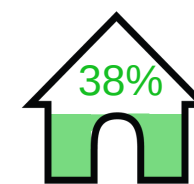

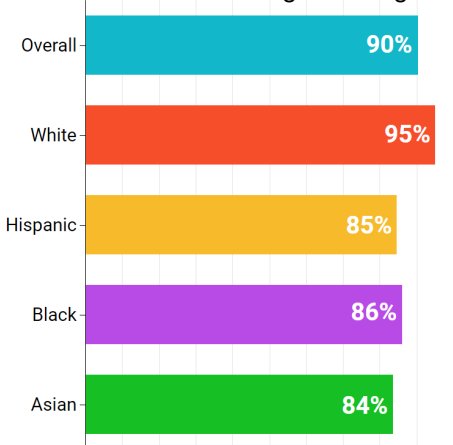

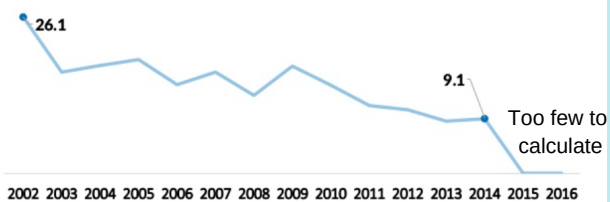

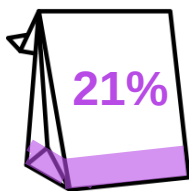
TEEN PREGNANCY ⁶

FREQUENCY OF ALCOHOL USE ²

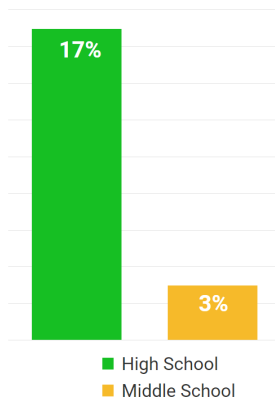

TOBACCO USE ²

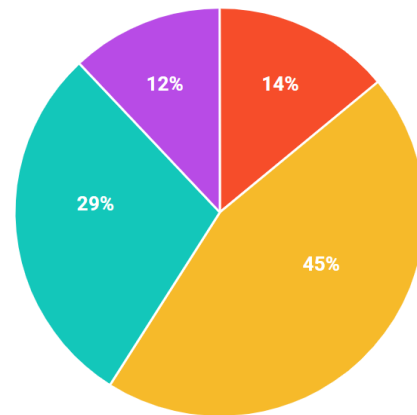

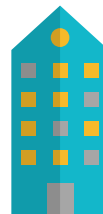
TOWN SERVICES ⁵
