# CDBG Program Overview

- The Town receives CDBG funding annually through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for:
  1. Providing decent affordable housing
  2. Creating suitable living environments
  3. Expanding economic opportunity
- Entitlement community designation



# CDBG National Objectives

- 1. Benefit low/moderate income households**
  - Households earning less than 80% Area Median Income (AMI=\$90,900; 80% AMI = \$72,700 for household of 4)
- 2. Aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight**
- 3. Meet an urgent need**



# CDBG Eligible Activities

1. Acquisition
2. Homebuyer Assistance
3. Housing Rehabilitation
4. Public Facilities
5. Public Services

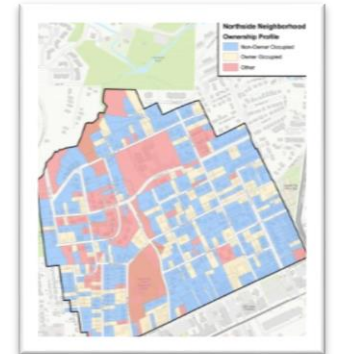

# Recommended Affordable Housing Activities

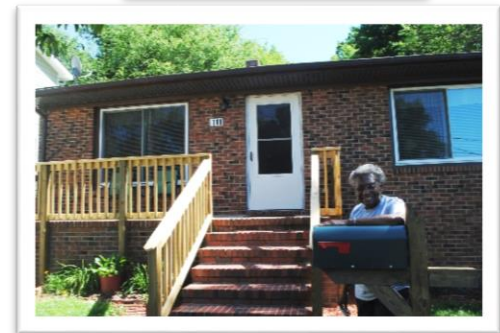
## 1. Acquisition and Rehabilitation- \$135,000

- ❑ EmPOWERment Inc.
- ❑ 2 Units of Permanently Affordable Housing
- ❑ *Full request*



## 2. Home Preservation - \$84,000

- ❑ \$24,000 for administration to Rebuilding Together of the Triangle
- ❑ \$60,000 for at least 6 rehabbed homes
- ❑ *Full request*



## 3. Neighborhood Revitalization - \$53,717

- ❑ Acquisition, rehab, demolition, public improvements
- ❑ *Balance of CDBG Award*



# Recommended Public Service Activities

15% Cap = \$62,935

## 3. Homeless Case Management – \$57,685

- Inter-Faith Council for Social Services
- Requested \$106,460*

## 4. Children's Parents Classes - \$5,250

- Exchange Club's Family Center of Alamance County
- Full request*
