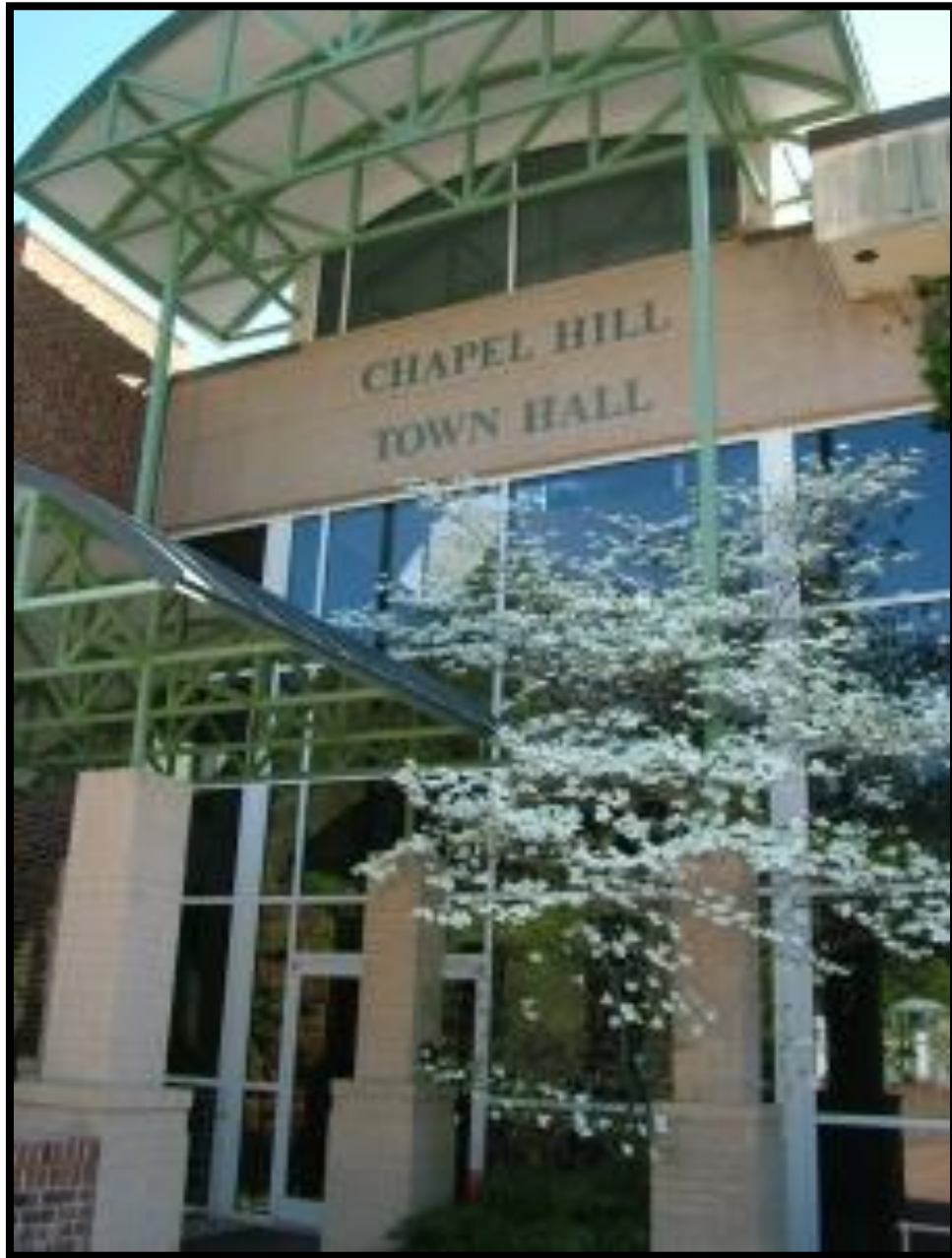

# TOWN RESPONSE TIMELINE

<b>Jan/Feb</b>	<b>Local Emergency Management coordination</b>
<b>Early March</b>	<b>Messages about COVID-19 prevention</b>
<b>March 12</b>	<b>Emergency Operations Center activated</b>
<b>March 13</b>	<b>Library, Parks &amp; Rec facilities close to public</b>
<b>March 19</b>	<b>Transit moves to reduced service</b>
<b>March 23</b>	<b>All Town facilities close to public, Town moves to Condition 1.5 - Variable Operations</b>
<b>March 27</b>	<b>County-wide Stay at Home (SAH) order goes into effect</b>
<b>Ongoing</b>	<b>Town's Emergency Operation Center (EOC) operational</b>

- **Outreach and education about the Stay at Home order**
- **Coordination to assess and meet community needs**
