A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE 2025-26 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (2026-01-21/R-2.3)

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2025 the Chapel Hill Town Council approved a 2025-2026 Community Development Block Grant Program Plan for use of \$689,588; and

WHEREAS, in December 2025 the Town identified \$76,615 in prior CDBG program year funds to be reallocated this program year; and

WHEREAS, in December 2025 Town staff determined local funding would be a better fit for a 2025-2026 Affordable Housing activity previously awarded \$100,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that based on the Town’s available funding of \$689,588 of 2025-2026 Community Development Block Grant funds, and \$76,615 of prior CDBG funds, the Council approves the following 2025-2026 Community Development Block Grant Program:
