OUR MISSION

Creating Partnership Catalyzing Affordable Housing Building Community



This year, Housing and Community continued to advance the Town Council's affordable housing and community connections goals.

Highlights from the year include:

- Awarding over <u>\$6 million to community partners</u> for affordable housing projects, with \$5 million from the Affordable Housing Bond.
- Supporting the development of 15 new affordable housing units and preservation of close to 200 units of affordable housing in the community.
- Developing an <u>Affordable Housing Preservation Strategy Framework</u>, which outlines a strategic approach for preserving existing affordable housing in Chapel Hill.
- Collaborating with the County, Carrboro, and Hillsborough to adapt our <u>Emergency Housing Assistance Program</u> to respond to community needs.
- Continuing to make progress towards developing affordable housing on Town land, selecting a potential development partner and creating a site plan for <u>2200 Homestead Road</u>.
- Developing a Town-wide <u>Language Access Plan</u>, which was unanimously adopted by the Town Council.
- Graduating 37 residents in the 2nd annual Peoples Academy.
- Joining the <u>Government Alliance for Race & Equity</u> (GARE) network and become a member of the NC GARE Learning Cohort Program.
- In collaboration with UNC, coordinating the <u>Good Neighbor Initiative</u>.
- Supporting 42 nonprofit agencies that provide vital community services through our <u>Human Services Program</u>.
- Coordinating the Town's Human Services <u>COVID-19 response efforts</u>, including distributing masks and food to vulnerable populations, developing multi-lingual resources, and adapting our programs to respond to increasing needs.
