BACKGROUND

What is a Certified Local Government (CLG)?

Local government whose local historic preservation program has been certified by the State Historic Preservation Officer to carry out the purposes of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966

Purpose of a CLG

Support the state and federal governments in promoting nationwide preservation initiatives

CLG BASICS

1. Requirements of a CLG

- Enforce state and local legislation for designating and protecting historic properties/resources
- Establish a historic district
- Survey and inventory historic properties
- Provide opportunity for public participation in local program
- Recommending properties to National Register of Historic Places (NRHP)
- Perform responsibilities of 1980 Historic Preservation Act






Types of Certificates of Appropriateness (COA) Received



Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) Rulings


