

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ON
TURN REGULATIONS (2023-11-15/O-2)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 21, Article III, Section 21-12. –Turn regulations, is hereby amended by adding a new subsection to Section 21-12(n) to read as follows:

“(n) It shall be unlawful for the driver of a vehicle of any kind to make a right turn on a red signal at the following intersections:

- 1) From Caswell Road (both approaches) to Estes Drive
- 2) Franklin Street and Eastgate Shopping Center Entrance
- 3) Franklin Street and Hillsborough Street
- 4) Franklin Street and Henderson Street
- 5) Raleigh Street and Cameron Avenue/Country Club Road
- 6) South Road and Country Club Road
- 7) From South Road (westbound approach only) to Columbia Street
- 8) Columbia Street and Rosemary Street
- 9) Columbia Street and Franklin Street
- 10) Columbia Street and Cameron Avenue
- 11) Pittsboro Street and Cameron Avenue
- 12) Rosemary Street and Hillsborough Street
- 13) Rosemary Street and Henderson Street
- 14) Rosemary Street and Church Street
- 15) Manning Drive and Ridge Road
- 16) Manning Drive and Paul Hardin Drive
- 17) Raleigh Road (NC 54) and Hamilton Road
- 18) South Columbia Street (US 15-501) and Mt. Carmel Church Road (westbound)”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on December 4, 2023.
