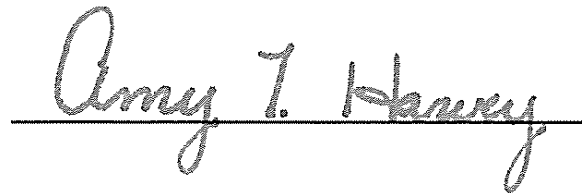

A RESOLUTION CONTINUING THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING FOR THE SPECIAL USE PERMIT MODIFICATION FOR CHAPEL HILL NORTH AT 1800 MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. BOULEVARD TO NOVEMBER 16, 2022 (2022-09-28/R-3)

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2022, the Town Council opened the Evidentiary Hearing for the Special Use Permit Modification application for Chapel Hill North at 1800 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and continued the item to June 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022, the applicant requested that the item be continued to September 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2022, the applicant requested that the item be continued to November 16, 2022.
