## A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NCDOT) PETITION FOR ABANDONMENT OF A SEGMENT OF SECONDARY ROAD 1799 ADJACENT TO GLEN LENNOX FROM THE STATE MAINTAINED SYSTEM (2023-06-21/R-4)

WHEREAS, NCDOT staff submitted a petition to remove 0.06 miles of Hayes Road (Secondary Road 1799) adjacent to Glen Lennox Drive from the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, previous road improvements have already eliminated this segment of roadway for vehicle access; and

WHEREAS, NCDOT staff and Town staff have evaluated the petition and find that no property owner would be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to their property; and

WHEREAS, NCDOT and Town staff find that there would be no negative impacts from maintenance being abandoned on the 0.06 miles of Hayes Road adjacent to Glen Lennox, Town staff therefore recommends approval of the petition; and
