Why Are We Here?

- Seven years to issue voter approved bonds
- Current authorization expires 11/03/2022
- NCGS 159-64 allows for 3 additional years to issue bonds
- New authorization extend to 11/03/2025
- Extension needed to provide additional time to complete projects

Stormwater



- Stormwater Improvements
 - Various high priority projects

Plan to issue remaining \$3.2 million in 2023/24

Solid Waste



- Solid Waste Transfer Station
 - Sited on Town owned land

\$ 5.2 million

No current plans to issue \$5.2 million

GO Bonds Issuance Schedule

- Town sends letter to LGC requesting 3-year extension
- LGC approves 3-year extension
- Council adopts resolution authorizing public hearing
- Town publishes notice of public hearing
- Council holds public hearing
- Council adopts bond order
