## Background

- Council requested a refined and streamlined funding process in the fall of 2017
- Council received an update December of 2017
- Human Services Program currently funds multiple agencies to work on a broad range of issues
- May be opportunities to deepen the impact to focus on outcomes and results



### Process

- Human Services Process Improvement Sub-Committee evaluated the Human Services Program
- Process rooted in design thinking approach
- Intended outcomes:
  - 1. A results-driven funding process that achieves the goals of the Town and is responsive to community needs
  - 2. Clearly defined funding priority areas, goals, and outcome measures
  - 3. A streamlined funding process



### Methodology

- Reviewed 2020 Comprehensive Plan and Council Goals to identify synergies
- Reviewed U.S. Census and other data sources to inform priority areas for funding
- Researched national best practices
- Conducted focus groups and surveys
- Involved Human Services Advisory Board in vetting Results Framework



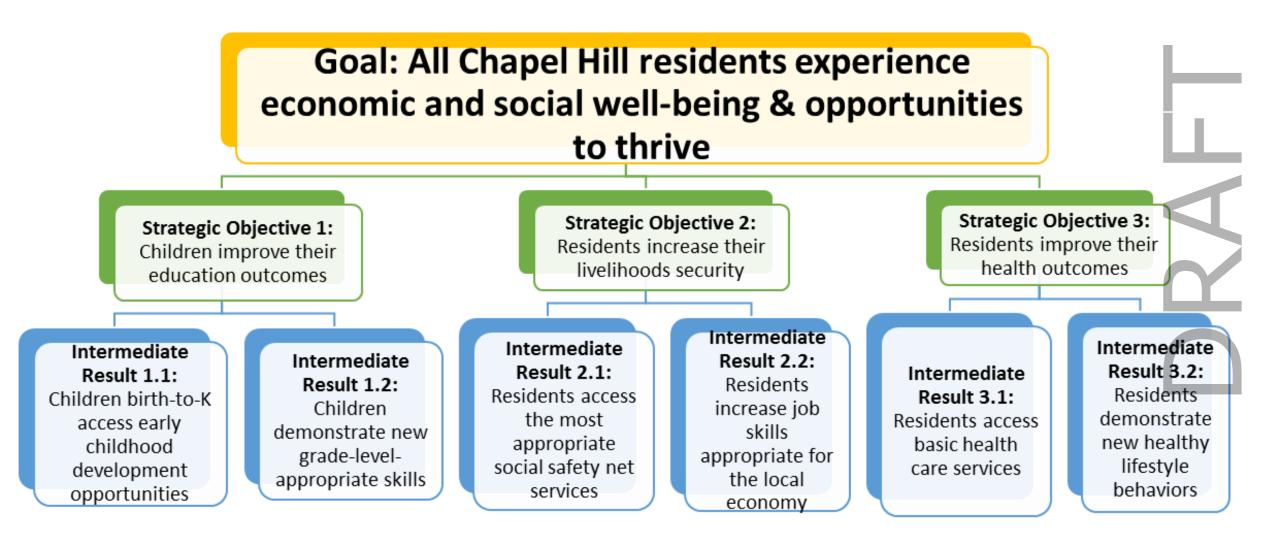
### **Findings – What We Learned**

- 1. Few funders implemented a holistic results oriented framework to prioritize funding and monitor outcomes
- 2. A Results Framework is a broadly used tool in the field of international development and public health



- 3. Health, education, and livelihood securities rose to the top as key community needs to be addressed
- 4. Housing continues to be broadly identified as a key community need
- 5. As the Program is currently structured, the Town's ability to deeply respond to the community's greatest needs is limited
- 6. The current process requires an extraordinary amount of time

#### **Human Services Results Framework**



### **Benefits of Using a Results Framework**

#### **1. Greater impact**

- Focus Town resources on human services needs identified as Town priorities in the Results Framework
- Increase capacity to measure the impact and return on the Town's investment

#### 2. Greater accountability

 Greater accountability to taxpayers by showing the overall impact of Human Services program through both data and story-telling

#### 3. Greater learning

- Increase capacity to evaluate the overall program and make adjustments that improve relevance, effectiveness, and efficiency
- Better assess what approaches contribute most effectively to achieving specific objectives

### Recommendations

- 1. Adopt the Results Framework to further focus the funding priorities and emphasis on measurable and specific results
- 2. Implement process changes to streamline the process:
  - Revise the funding application to align with the proposed Results Framework
  - Move to a paperless, online application process
  - Pilot abbreviated application and review process for funding requests below \$5,000
  - Pilot "High Impact Award" Grant to provide up to 3 larger grants in the range of \$30-50,000
  - Coordinate with Orange County and the Town of Carrboro
- 3. Evaluate the revised process after the first year of implementation, surveying agencies and HSAB, and making adjustments as needed



### **Next Steps**

- 1. Continue to refine agency performance indicators
- 2. Revise the funding application to align with the Results Framework
- 3. Develop pilot detail for High Impact Award and Small Grant Programs
- 4. Conduct Results Framework orientation sessions
- 5. Implement prototype for FY20-21 funding cycle
