Subject: Council Questions: Item 13: Chapel Hill High

Council Question: Was any consideration given to the traffic plan proposed by community members the last time this item came to Council?

Staff Response: *The School District has considered the alternative transportation plan submitted by Pamela Schultz, although elected not to pursue this option. One notable benefit to the Schools for its current proposal is emergency access to the south, which Ms. Schultz's alternative does not provide. Town staff and the Town's transportation consultant have studied the transportation program proposed by the School District and find that the mitigation measures proposed are sufficient to manage future transportation patterns caused by the project. If the School District were to submit an alternative plan to the Town, then Town staff would formally review that proposal.*
