## RECOMMENDATION Parking Payment-in-Lieu Ordinances January 25, 2022

**Motion:** 

The Transportation and Connectivity Advisory Board (TCAB) declined to recommend approval of the Parking Payment-in-Lieu ordinances. Members of TCAB expressed concerns with:

- The establishment of parking minimums;
- The lack of possibility for funds to go towards other modes of travel;
- The additional cost posing a barrier to affordable housing and small business;
- The lack of demonstrated need for additional funding for parking structures,
- The lack of mention of EVs;
- Maintaining the character of Chapel Hill;
- Peak demand driving the parking requirements and the need for additional parking;
- The future use of parking structures if parking demand changes and possible conversion to other uses;
- Promoting single occupancy vehicle trips in opposition to the Mobility/Climate Action Plan, and;
- The economic viability of the plan.
