- HUD requires public housing entities submit an annual plan and five-year plan
- Plans must include how funding will be used

What Is In The 5-Year Plan

- Achieve and maintain HUD's PHAS high performer score of 90 or above
- Continue to maintain public housing units using \$2.26 Million in capital fund grants currently available
- Procure A/E services to create a physical needs assessment of the aging portfolio
- Create repositioning plan for all PH communities
- Expand resources offered to residents

FY 2026 – FY 2030 Capital Fund Action Plan

- We plan to spend \$937,504 on variety of major systems that need replacement or repair
- We also plan to use **\$117,188** for management improvement for staff training to help improve the Town's PHAS score
- HUD allows up to 10 percent of the total grant \$117,188 to go toward administration costs--Salaries
