WHEREAS, September 17, 2021 marks the two hundred thirty-fourth anniversary of the adoption of the U.S. Constitution by the Philadelphia Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this momentous occasion during this anniversary and further celebrate the establishment of our free and democratic society;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Chapel Hill Town Council, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 - 23, 2020
