AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-74 OF THE TOWN CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO IMPOSE BY PROCLAMATION ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY TO PROMOTE PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE (2020-06-10/O-1)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11, Article V, Section 11-74 of the Town Code is hereby amended by adding the following language:

“(7) Regulate the number of persons who can gather outdoors or indoors during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts;

(8) Regulate and prohibit the operation of public and private offices and businesses, and indoor and outdoor public and private recreational facilities during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts;

(9) Require the wearing of face coverings during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts.”

Section 2. The validity of any and all proclamations of the Mayor entered into prior to the enactment of this Ordinance in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency are hereby validated and confirmed pursuant to the authority hereby granted.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon enactment.
