## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-74 OF THE TOWN CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO IMPOSE BY PROCLAMATION ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY TO PROMOTE PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE (2020-06-10/0-1)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11, Article V, Section 11-74 of the Town Code is hereby amended by adding the following language:

- "(7) Regulate the number of persons who can gather outdoors or indoors during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts;
- (8) Regulate and prohibit the operation of public and private offices and businesses, and indoor and outdoor public and private recreational facilities during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts;
- (9) Require the wearing of face coverings during a public health crisis as established by a local or State-declared State of Emergency, subject to reasonable exceptions established upon the advice of public health experts."
- Section 2. The validity of any and all proclamations of the Mayor entered into prior to the enactment of this Ordinance in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency are hereby validated and confirmed pursuant to the authority hereby granted.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon enactment.
