# **OPTIONS TO MOVE FORWARD**

Engage the community in planning for enhancements at AD Clark Pool

 This could include converting wading pool to a splash pad area and/or other upgrades



# **OPTIONS TO MOVE FORWARD**

Complete feasibility study in order to fully consider options within the parks system

- Parks would be analyzed and rated for suitability and size of splash pad
- Drawings would be developed to show smaller and larger options
- Community engagement would be integral to the process
- Work Group would help to guide the study
- Parks, Greenways, & Recreation Commission and Council would weigh in on the options presented

## **OPTIONS TO MOVE FORWARD**

Implement Pop-Up splash pad concept

 Exploring this as a temporary, mobile solution to meet short-term needs

Could be incorporated into existing



# CONSIDERATIONS: DESTINATION ATTRACTION; ACCESS

# Larger Destination Splash Pad

- Sought out by families from across the area
- Appeals to wider age range
- Connection to parks with other amenities
- A venue for birthday parties, group outings
- More costly to construct and to operate





# CONSIDERATIONS: DESTINATION ATTRACTION; ACCESS Multiple Smaller Splash Pads

- The number of households able to walk to a splash area could increase by having features at multiple locations
- Opportunity to utilize multiple designs (e.g., contemporary, nature-based, etc.)
- Less costly to operate (no staffing)
