RECOMMENDATION Bicycle and Pedestrian Payment-in-Lieu Ordinance March 15, 2022

- **Motion:** Jonathan Mitchell moved and Neal Bench seconded a motion to recommend approval of the proposed text amendment to the Land Use Management Ordinance to address payments-in-lieu of pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure with the following language:
 - (e) Bicycle and pedestrian systems in the vicinity of the development site shall be <u>connected or</u> extended to the site to the extent practicable. Access to the site shall be in compliance with and coordinate to existing and future town bicycle and pedestrian systems and the systems of adjacent developments. Bicycle, pedestrian and transit improvements shall be installed along all public streets within and on the external street frontage of the development, to the extent practicable, in accordance with provisions in the Chapel Hill Design Manual.
 - (f) When extending or installing bicycle and pedestrian systems is not practicable or reasonable, the applicant for the development site may make a payment-in-lieu, subject to prior approval from the Town Manager. The payment shall be based on the average cost of recent past bids for the specific type of improvement not being provided.
