WHEREAS, Coach Davis, a former UNC player and assistant coach, is the first rookie coach to reach the Final Four since former UNC Coach Bill Guthridge in 1998; and

WHEREAS, Armando Bacot, Caleb Love, RJ Davis, Leaky Black, Brady Manek, Puff Johnson, and the rest of the team gifted Tar Heel Nation thrills, joy and excitement and brought positive energy to Chapel Hill through their grit, determination, teamwork, and heart, overcoming challenge after challenge to become only the fourth #8 seed to reach the NCAA Tournament final game; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill is proud to congratulate and recognize the accomplishments of Coach Davis and his extraordinary and inspirational team, wishing them continued luck as student-athletes and throughout their careers.
