# Adjustments Based on Council Feedback

- Property tax rate of **52.2 cents** (.8 cent increase on transit tax rate)
- Added Economic Development Admin Coordinator position (\$81,995)
- Removed Compensation Analyst position (\$58,039)
- Fund IFC interlocal agreement based on population formula (258,000)
- Fund Partnership to End Homelessness Request for SOHRAD (\$126,000)

# IFC & Partnership to End Homelessness

**Total Request for IFC (\$258K) and Partnership (\$126K)= \$384,000**

# IFC & Partnership Gap Options

Funding Gap = \$115,561

- Option 1: Allocate Fund Balance one-time funding
- Option 2: Reduce Class & Comp Reserve recurring funding
- Option 3: Reduce Cost of Service Increases recurring funding
