The Community Policing Advisory Committee by a unanimous vote have agreed to the following recommendations. We respectfully present these recommendations to the Town Council for consideration:

- 1. Change the Name of the Community Policing Advisory Committee to:
 - The Community Safety Advisory Committee
- 2. Modify the Charge of the Community Policing Advisory Committee to:
 - Engage with the community and community partners on public safety and policing through conversation and education
 - Serve as a liaison to enhance community and police relations
 - Serve as a platform/springboard for community-based initiatives to Town Council that could benefit community safety
 - Proactively engaged and consulted by Town Council throughout the development of initiatives related to community safety
 - Make recommendations to the Town and to CHPD, regarding public safety, best practices, organizational matters, and procedures:

- Require a yearly review of CPAC's charge and to propose those changes to Town Council
